NEW CONVERT'S SUBSIDY POLICY

PURPOSE: The new convert subsidy is to assist families new to the Adventist Church who have enrolled their children for the first time in an Adventist school, or to assist recent converts whose parents are not Adventists.

- BENEFITS: 1. The new convert subsidy shall be funded from the Union, Conference and local church. The total scholarship shall be set by the Conference Board of Education. 2. The subsidy will be prorated for a student who leaves prior to the end of a semester.

ELIGIBILITY: Church membership will have been established during the 18-month period immediately preceding school enrollment.

EXCLUSIONS: Students will not receive concurrent benefits from other conference scholarships and the new convert subsidies.

- PROCEDURES: 1. School Board recommends new convert to Church Board. 2. Church Board approves and makes request to conference.
